

20-Year Exclusive Limited "Metal" Warranty Painted Aluminum & Galvalume Steel

This Warranty is issued by Onesource Coil Coaters, LLC. ("OCC"), to the customer identified in this certificate, ("Customer") and covers Aluminum and Galvalume steel painted with OCC COOLSOURCE® , Kynar 500®, or Hylar 5000® resin (collectively Fluropon®) paint systems sold for use as building roofing and/or siding panels.

1. In regions located North of 15' North Latitude and South of 15' South Latitude: This Warranty applies if any of the following Warranty Conditions occurs:

- A. Within 20 years from the date of application of the paint, Fluropon® exhibits flaking or peeling (loss of adhesion) to an extent that is apparent on ordinary outdoor visual observation. Minute fracturing, which may occur in proper fabrication of building parts, is not a covered Warranty Condition. Failure due to substrate corrosion is not a covered Warranty Condition.
- B. Within 20 years from the date of installation of the panels, Fluropon®:
 - 1. Chalks in excess of ASTM D-4214-98 method A D659 number eight (8) rating when properly maintained as described herein, and
 - 2. Changes color more than five (5) Hunter delta-E units as determined by ASTM method D-2244-02. Color change shall be measured on an exposed painted surface that has been cleaned of surface soils and chalk and the corresponding values measured on the original or unexposed painted surface. Color changes may not be uniform on surfaces that are not equally exposed to the sun and elements and OCC does not warrant that color changes will be uniform.

2. In regions between 15" North Latitude and 15" South Latitude: This Warranty applies if any of the following Warranty Conditions occurs:

- A. Within 10 years from the date of application of the paint, Fluropon® exhibits flaking or peeling (loss of adhesion) to an extent that is apparent on ordinary outdoor visual observation. Minute fracturing, which may occur in proper fabrication of the building parts, is not a covered Warranty Condition. Failure due to substrate corrosion is not a covered Warranty Condition.
- B. Within 10 years from the date of installation of the panels, Fluropon®:
 - 1. Chalks in excess of ASTM D-4214-98 method A D659 number eight (8) rating when properly maintained as described herein, and;
 - 2. Changes color more than five (5) Hunter delta-E units as determined by ASTM method D-2244-02. Color change shall be measured on an exposed painted surface that has been cleaned of surface soils and chalk and the corresponding values measured on the original or unexposed painted surface. Color changes may not be uniform on surfaces that are not equally exposed to the sun and elements and OCC does not warrant that color changes will be uniform.

3. If a Warranty condition occurs and the other requirements of this warranty are met, OCC will supply you with the following Warranty Benefits:

OCC will pay for labor and material reasonably necessary to repaint, repair or replace, at our option, the metal panels showing the Warranty Conditions. The Warranty Benefits shall not exceed the original purchase price of the affected metal panels (not including any accessories or attachments) or the remedy provided in any other warranty provided to the building owner, whichever is less. This Warranty will continue to apply to any metal panels that were repainted, repaired or replaced due to a Warranty Condition, but only for the unexpired portion of the Warranty period applicable to the original part.

4. This warranty pertains to product used outside of Continental United States, Alaska and Canada. For investigations three steps will be followed:

- A. The initial claim will be submitted to your Warranty Administrator with complete order identification and photographs of the field failure. If the claim can not be resolved after review of submitted information, laboratory records and quality control tests, proceed to step b or if appropriate directly to step c.
- B. Your field representative with technical experience will make a field examination to obtain additional data, photographs and an appropriate size sample from a problem panel. Your company and OCC will submit all data, photographs and samples to a testing laboratory for analysis. If claim remains unresolved proceed to step c.
- C. A technical expert from OCC and a representative from your company may make a final field examination. The travel expenses of the Valspas expert may be negotiable up to 100% and may be paid for by your company.

5. There are circumstances where our limited Warranty does not apply. That is because the failure may be caused by things that we don't control. These include:

- A. Acts of God, falling objects, explosions, or fire;
- B. Harmful fumes or foreign substances in the atmosphere, standing water or salt spray;
- C. When roof is not uniformly insulated;
- D. Failure to store or install products coated with Fluropon® in a way that allows for adequate circulation. Condensation attributable to improper packaging, handling, shipping, processing and/ or installation;
- E. Failures or damage resulting from edge corrosion or failure of the metal substrate;
- F. Development of any other condition between the coating and the substrate which causes the coating to degrade or delaminate, including any failure or deficiency in the cleaning process or pretreatment;
- G. Direct or Indirect contact with animals or animal waste;

H. Mishandling of Fluropon® or of any substrate coated with it, including abuse, alteration, modification, improper use, or storage;

I. Where materials / items such as snow guards and solar panels are attached / adhered to the product;

J. Other circumstances or occurrences beyond OCC's control.

6. No Warranty is provided for Fluropon® on any substrate that is subjected to sea spray or installed on property located 1,500 or fewer feet from a salt-water environment.

7. This warranty applies only to building parts installed on buildings outside of the Continental United States, Alaska and Canada. This Warranty will automatically expire upon any change or transfer of ownership of the property on which the metal coated with Fluropon® is originally installed.

8. This is our only warranty concerning Fluropon® coil coatings. Except for this Warranty, WE MAKE NO WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED AND DISCLAIM ALL IMPLIED WARRANTIES INCLUDING WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR USE OR FREEDOM FROM PATENT INFRINGEMENT. OCC WILL NOT BE LIABLE FOR ANY SPECIAL, INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES. We have no other liability with respect to Fluropon® coil coatings, whether based on warranty, negligence or any other legal theory.

9. This is our complete warranty. It lists all of OCC's obligations regarding Fluropon® coil coatings purchased by you on or after the effective date shown below. It is only for your benefit and you may not assign it to any other person or entity. OCC makes no warranty to your customers, and is not responsible for any warranty you choose to provide to your customers concerning the performance of Fluropon® coil coatings. OCC may change or discontinue this Warranty by providing you with 30 days advance written notice. Any changes will apply only to Fluropon® coil coatings sold to you after the notice period expires.

10. GOVERNING LAW

The substantive law of the State of Florida shall exclusively govern the rights and duties of the parties under this Agreement. Any controversy or claim arising out of or related to this Warranty, or the breach thereof, shall be brought before a court of competent jurisdiction in Pinellas County, Florida.

11. NOT EFFECTIVE UNLESS SIGNED

This Warranty is not valid unless signed by both an authorized employee or agent of OCC and an authorized employee or agent of Customer.
